

What are the main differences between WSET Online, Self-paced Courses and Capital Wine School Online Live WSET courses?

WSET Online Self-paced Courses

- Self-paced, self-study, no live instruction or set login times.
- WSET London-based instructors available by to assist by email.
- Wines for tasting are purchased and paid for by the student except for any tasting tutorial that is included in the course.
- Textbook and study guide are in e-book format (printed materials available for purchase separately).
- In-class or virtual single session tasting tutorials taught by CWS instructors for Level 3 and for Diploma units D3, D4, and D5.



CWS Online Live WSET Courses

- Classes are conducted live at set times on WebEx or Zoom (most classes are recorded for later viewing, but this is not guaranteed so students are encouraged to attend scheduled classes)
- CWS instructors (WSET Diploma graduates and/or Masters of Wine)
- Wine samples are included and available for curbside pickup by appointment (except for Unit D2 & D6))
- Printed textbook & study guide included with course for Levels 1-3. Diploma books are in e-book format and online PDF files.
